The AGAR was not accurately completed before submission for review.

Section 2 Box 8 includes a property fund. As a result of this the figures in 2016/17 Boxes 1, 7, 8 and 9 should be £513,732, £551,418, £418,748 and £200,000 respectively. Therefore, the figures in Section 2 Boxes 1, 7, 8 and 9 for 2017/18 should be £551,418, £462,731, £329,546 and £200,000 respectively. Please ensure that amendments are corrected in the prior year comparatives when completing next year's AGAR.
