1. Policing in Bridgwater – A representative from Bridgwater’s Police Team (if present) are invited to provide updates and discuss issues in Bridgwater.

The Local Beat Manager provided an overview of areas the Police have been working on over the last 12 months. There has been pockets of ASB and these has been addressed by the local beat team. Other issues concerning rough sleepers and drinking in the Town Centre were raised. The Police also conducted a vehicle and speed check in the High Street in November 2018.
