

West Street Stalls generator Conditions

St. Matthew's Fair Bridgwater Wednesday 25th – Saturday 28th September 2024

Traders must ensure all their cabling and plugs are undamaged and in good repair.

Only 16-amp CE 17 plugs or BS 4343 16amp industrial plugs to be used.

Whilst the Council undertakes to provide a centrally located power supply to each stall, should additional cabling be required (i.e., for freezer units), the stallholder must hire this from Power and Pyro Ltd at a reasonable fee (plus returnable deposit) or provide it themselves.

It will not be the Council's responsibility to provide an electrical repair service. Traders who do not provide compliant equipment will undertake to repair same themselves or by paying a fee to Power and Pyro Ltd.

The electrical installation must comply with the following:

- Health and Safety Executive Guidance Note GS50 (second edition) Electrical Safety at Places of Entertainment
- The current edition of the Installation of Electrical Engineers Regulations
- Regulations under the Electricity Act
- Any special regulations issued by the Local Electricity Supply Authority
- The Electricity at Work Regulations 1989
