



Hinkley Point C Look ahead

We continually monitor the light, noise and dust emissions from Hinkley Point C Site to ensure that our construction works have a minimal impact. However, you may still see and hear some aspects of the work. This is a summary of some of our current works:

Location		Description of works
1	Southern Landscape Area	Finishing of landscaping works including reseeded with species-rich grassland.
2	Southern Construction Phase Area	Processing of materials and stockpiling continues.
3	Unit 1	The largest concrete pour at HPC to date, 9,000 m ³ , is scheduled to take place in June this year.
4	Unit 2	Excavation works on Unit 2 are nearing completion and the pre-stressing gallery construction has commenced.
5	Jetty	Over the next few months you will start to see ships docking at the jetty.
6	Sarens Giant Crane	The Sarens heavy lift crane, the largest land based crane in the world, will be delivered to site and assembled in Spring 2019.
	Off-site	Delivery of the Tunnel Boring Machine components are expected through Combwich later this year. Compound works will continue at the Combwich Wharf site alongside other enabling works.
